Receipts

The NP coordinator has successfully completed the return to Locality for the existing £9k grant and examining the possibility of a further grant of £8k, given the aim to design the Calcutta Club site identified in the draft Sevenoaks Local Plan.

Payments

The NP coordinator costs are agreed by the Parish Council at the Parish Council meeting and initially met by the main Parish Council budget There are no other costs this month.
